RULES FOR THE USE OF THE MEADOWS POOL(S)

POOL RULES

- A resident of The Meadows may request use of The Meadows' pool(s) for a party of 20 or more by making application at least one (1) week prior to the event. *This does not mean that guests of the party have exclusive use of the pool(s)* but must be considerate of other Meadows residents who wish to use the pool(s).
- A usage fee of \$100 plus a refundable security deposit of \$100 must accompany the application. Checks are to be made payable to "Meadows HOA." A minimum of \$300,000 liability insurance is required. The applicant must add The Meadows at Martin Downs Homeowners Association, Inc., as additionally named insured for the date of the event. *A certificate of insurance must be submitted along with the application.*
- The applicant must be in attendance at all times during the event. He/she must report all accidents, emergencies, damage, furniture or building or landscape damage which may have occurred to the Property Manager immediately or by the following workday. The applicant is responsible for the care of the pool area and furniture and is liable for any and all damages which may occur during use. An inspection of the area, with the applicant present, will be made both before and after the event. The \$100 security deposit is contingent upon a satisfactory inspection. Exceptions must be approved by the Board.
- For functions of 20 or more, a security guard must be hired to control parking and supervise the area. It is possible to arrange a guard from Martin County Sheriff's Department. Contact the Sheriff's department directly to make arrangements. Applicant is required to provide a list of names of all guests to Security at the gate prior to guests' arrival.
- *For each fifteen (15) guests under the age of fourteen (14) two (2) chaperones must be present at all times.*

1. No diving or jumping into pool.
2. Hours of operation are from 7:00 a.m. to 9:00 p.m.
3. Shower before entering pool - no soap to be used.
4. No lifeguard on duty - swim at your own risk.
5. Violators of Pool Rules may lose pool privileges.
6. Bathing suits only in the pool - no shorts or cutoffs.
7. Children under 3 years of age must wear rubber pants.
8. Children under 14 must be supervised by an adult.
9. No rafts or large floats allowed in pool.
10. No running, ball playing, or rough play of any kind in the pool area.
11. No skates, skateboards, mopeds, bicycles, or roller blades in pool area.
12. No animals in pool or in pool area.
13. No food in pool or in pool area, except at a Board sanctioned function.
14. No glass or drinks in glass containers allowed in pool or in pool area. No beverages allowed within four (4) feet of wet deck. No alcoholic beverages allowed in pool area except at a Board sanctioned function.
15. Only radios with earphones allowed in pool area.
16. No furniture to be removed from pool area.
17. Bathing load is 120 persons for the adult pool and 15 persons for wading pool, at one time.
18. Groups of 20 or more must fill out an application at the office for use of the Meadows pool, and comply with all terms of the application.
19. Violation of these rules may result in a fine.
