Gardenia (grafted variety only, needs spray)

Crepe Myrtle (bare in winter,
flowers May/August)

slowing growing, easy maintenance)

Powder Puff (use in open area, hand trim)
Southern Magnolia (needs spraying)
Fern Tree (expensive)
Pidgeon Plum (expensive)
East Palatka Holly (red – has berries)
Chinese Fan Palm (needs lots of room)
European Fan Palm (has fuzzy leaf)
Foxtail Palm
Lady Palm (in shade ONLY)
Laurel Oak (cone shape)
Live Oak (use in open area, branches shoot out)
Majesty Palm (very expensive)
Pony Tail Palm (expensive)
Podocarpus (well drained areas only)
Queen Palm (needs fertilizing)
Sabal Palm
Savannah Holly
Roebelenii Palm (Pygmy Date Palm)
Do not plant near sidewalks – has thorns
Christmas Palm (Madagascar Palm)
Needs fertilizing – very expensive
